

The mission of the [Mobile Crisis Team of Harford County](#) is to provide crisis intervention and emergency mental health care for all residents of Harford County. By offering onsite mental health assessment, crisis intervention, and referral services, we strive to provide an alternative to hospital emergency room visits for those in need of urgent mental health services. Our goal is to make an appropriate referral and arrangement to resolve the presenting crisis, avoiding hospitalization whenever possible, by utilizing community support and resources.

Our specially-trained team of clinicians can provide onsite services in the following situations:

- Mental health emergencies
- Strange/bizarre behavior
- Disaster mental health relief
- Critical incident stress management
- Victim crises
- Law enforcement crisis intervention

OUR TEAM

Our team includes experienced mental health clinicians who specialize in providing psychiatric evaluations and crisis intervention. The team works in pairs when in the community, or independently when working in secure locations. The team approach is critical for the safety of the clinicians and allows for flexibility in situations in which multiple individuals or agencies are involved in the resolution of a crisis.

HOURS

Mobile Crisis Services are available every day from 8 a.m. until midnight.

FUNDING

The Mobile Crisis Team is funded by and in cooperation with Office on Mental Health, Core Service Agency of Harford County, Inc., which plans and manages the Public Mental Health System in Harford County. This is a non-profit, tax-exempt organization primarily serving Medicaid and indigent county residents with mental health needs.

EXCLUSIONS

We are unable to provide services in the following situations:

- Weapons or active criminal activity
- Intoxicated individuals or those with a primary addiction problem
- Social service issues such as housing needs, financial crisis, transportation, or other situations not involving mental illness
