Eligibility

- Candidates must have earned, or be on track to earn, a master's degree (e.g., MHA, MBA, MHSA, MPH, or a related field) in May 2026 or later.
- Candidates who are on schedule to receive a master's degree upon completion of a fellowship are eligible. Degree conferral is not required for this position.
- Relevant healthcare industry experience (prior work experience, internship, externship, research, etc.) is preferred.
- Candidates from CAHME-accredited programs are preferred.
- Fellows will begin their fellowship in June 2027.
