Sunscreen Policy

July 1, 2021

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

It is the policy of The Special Education Programs of the Sheppard Pratt Health System to maintain compliance with Student Sunscreen Use Policies of the state of Maryland. This policy is designed to ensure students have access to sunscreen when needed on school property or at school-sponsored activities.

Sunscreen will be available for any activities that will expose students to the sun for 30 minutes or more. The Frost School will use sunscreens that are indicated for sensitive skin and with an SPF of 30 or higher. Parents/Guardians may also choose to send in personal sunscreen lotion for students with specific needs.

Parents/Guardians who prefer their students use personal sunscreen lotion should send a new, unopened bottle of lotion. Parents should attach a note stating that they request the school use a specific suntan lotion.
