Frederick Turkey Trot FAQ

1. Are strollers allowed?

Yes, this is a kid-friendly and stroller-friendly event. Bicycles are not permitted.

2. Are dogs permitted?

No. We ask that you please leave your pets at home.

3. Where do I park for the race?

We encourage people to make use of the three parking decks that are within three blocks of the start/finish area. Court Street, W. Patrick Street, and E. Church Street are all great options. There is no parking permitted in the start/finish area on 2nd Street, College Avenue, or the park-side of Carroll Parkway (across from Parkway Elementary School).

4. What happens if there's inclement weather?

We race rain or shine. We are unable to provide any refunds.

5. Will water be provided for participants?

There will *not* be a water station on the course. We suggest that you bring your own water bottle to the start line filled and ready to go if needed. Water and snacks will be provided at the finish line for race participants.

6. Where do I find race results?

At the top of the RunSignup page, you will see the 'Results' tab. Select the correct distance and type in your bib number or name to see results.

7. When is the cut-off for registration?

Online registration is open through 11:59 p.m. on November 23. You can also register at packet pick-up. Registration will not be available on race day at the event.

8. When/where is packet pick-up?

Packet pick-up will be located at [604 Solarex Court, Frederick, MD 21703](#), Monday, November 21, 4:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.; Tuesday, November 22, 4:00



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p.m. – 8:00 p.m.; Wednesday, November 23: 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. There is no packet pick-up on race day.

9. When will I receive my packet if I opted in for shipping?

Registrants that selected the shipping option and signed up before October 22 will receive two packages prior to race day, one package with your race shirt(s), and a second with your bib(s).

10. Can I switch my in-person registration to virtual registration?

11. Will there be an award ceremony after the race?

There will not be an award ceremony. There will be a table with medals for the winners. Awards are for the in-person 5K only. 5K awards will include top three overall male and female, and the top three in each age group. Age groups are as follows: 12 and under, 13-15, 16-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70+.

12. Will my award be mailed to me if I am unable to pick up after the race?

Yes, we will ship medals to those that are unable to pick up after the race.
